Patrick Esmonde, MSE, serves as CEO and Co-Founder of Vestibular First and Dizzy Care Network. An experienced technologist, business leader, and educator, he brings a background in information systems, technology management, and operational leadership to the vestibular field.

At Vestibular First, Patrick worked alongside his wife and Co-Founder, Helena Esmonde, to prototype and refine the Insight Infrared Video Goggles. He later led the scale-up of the company's manufacturing processes, supporting FDA clearance in 2020. His work with Vestibular First has focused on improving access to practical, affordable tools for vestibular diagnostics and rehabilitation.

At Dizzy Care Network, Patrick focuses on improving how individuals with dizziness are connected to appropriate clinical care. The platform is designed to support patients who may otherwise move between multiple providers before receiving a clear diagnosis or treatment direction. His work centers on expanding the application across different care settings, from mobile practices and specialty clinics to larger healthcare systems, while supporting clinicians with patient information that can help guide evaluation and care planning.

Patrick earned a Bachelor's degree in Business and Management Information Systems from Drexel University and a Master's in Technology Management from the University of Pennsylvania, a joint program from The Wharton School and the School of Engineering and Applied Science. He has also served as an educator, sharing his expertise as an adjunct assistant professor at Villanova University's School of Business, teaching IT strategy in the MBA program, and has held Information Systems leadership roles in higher education for more than 10 years.
